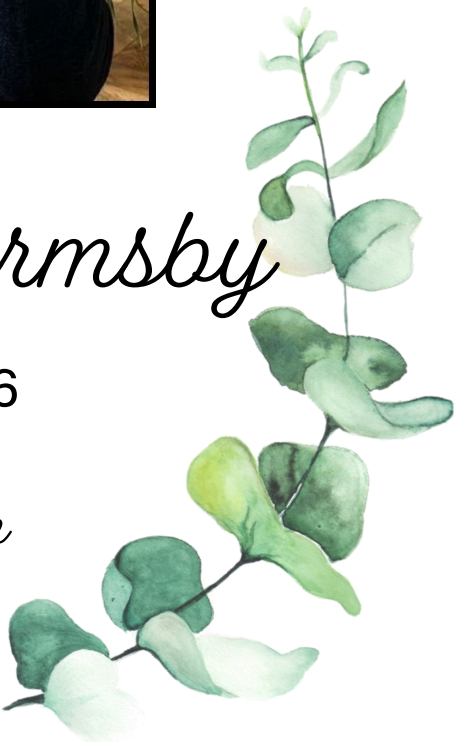

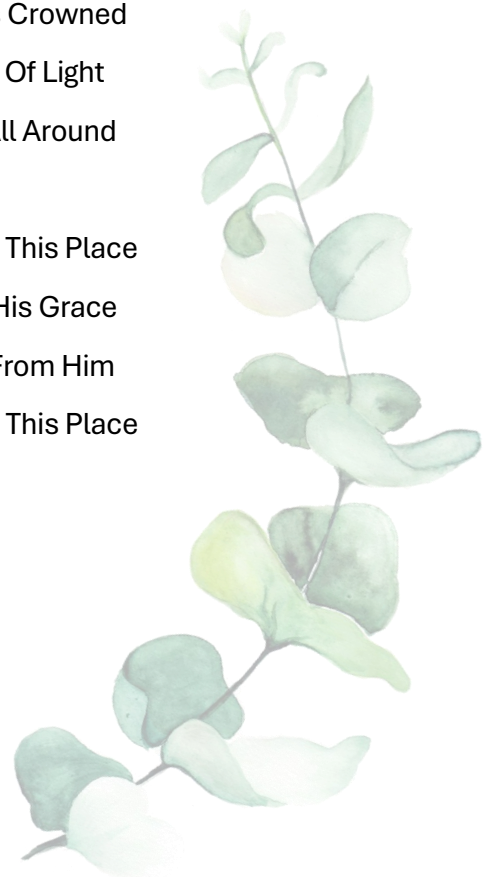

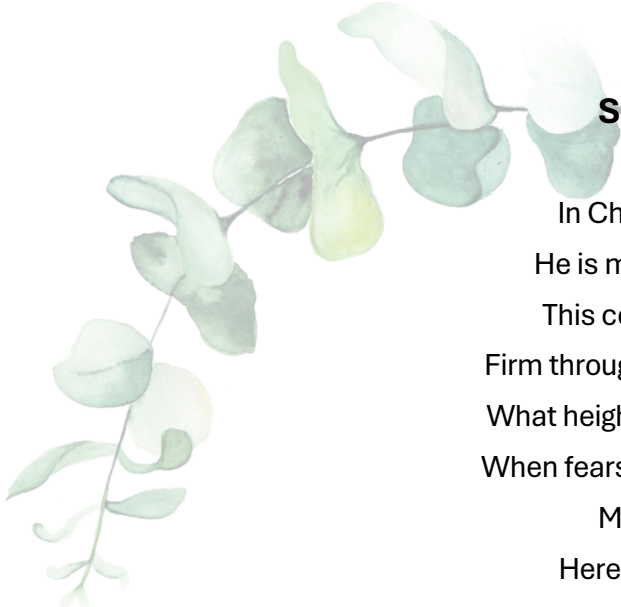

Song: In Christ Alone

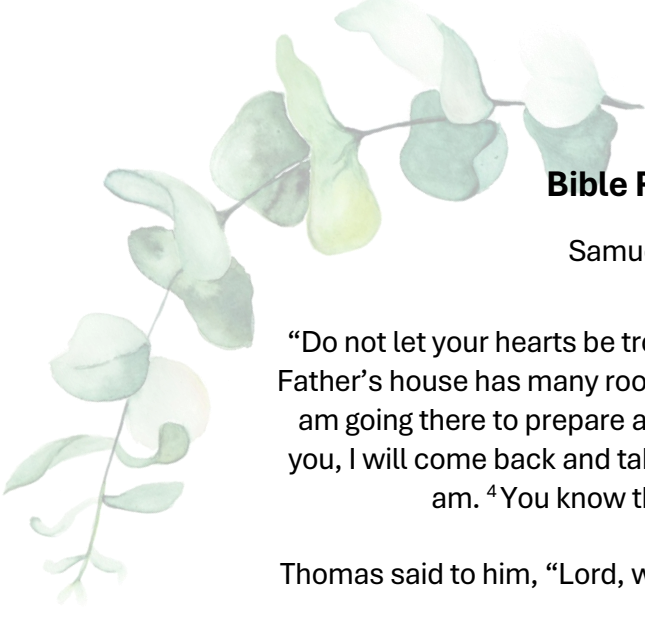
In Christ alone my hope is found
